**transport** Transport to/from Awana will be by aircon coaches. Campers must assemble at Life BPC at 6.30am on 9 June 2008 for coach departure. ETA at Awana Genting is about 4.30pm. ETA in Singapore on 13 June 2008 is about 9:30pm.

**passport & visa** International passports must be valid till 9 December 2008. Singapore passport holders do not require a Visa. For nationals from other countries, please check with the Malaysian embassy for the latest visa requirement.

**registration** This Bible Camp is open only to Lifers and Visitors who are worshipping in Life BPC. Acceptance will be made on a first-come-first-served basis. The closing date for registration is 25 May 2008 (Sunday) or upon full allocation of available accommodation, whichever is earlier. To stay together in a room, please register together. To register, please submit one camp registration form and one photocopy of passport details per person to the Camp Registration Office.

**registration** 10:45 am to 12:30 pm on Sundays.  
9:00 am to 11:00 am & 1.00 pm to 5:00 pm from Mondays to Fridays.

**camp fees** Full payment must be made latest by 25 May 2008 (Sunday). Cheques should be crossed and made payable to "Life B-P Church" or "Life Bible-Presbyterian Church", with your name indicated on the reverse of the cheque.

**withdrawal** **Withdrawal made after 25 May 2008 (Sunday) incurs a cancellation fee of \$20 per camper. Withdrawal made after 1 June 2008 (Sunday) incurs a 100% forfeit of camp fees.**

**accommodation** All accommodation will be at the Tower Block only. Each room comes with 2 queen-sized beds with bathroom amenities for 2 guests. No extra bed. There are NO interconnecting rooms. Adjoining rooms will be allocated to families based on needs and are subject to availability.

**camp briefing** There will be a camp briefing on 3 June 2008 (Tuesday) at 7:15 pm in the Chinese Service Hall. Attendance is compulsory for all campers.
