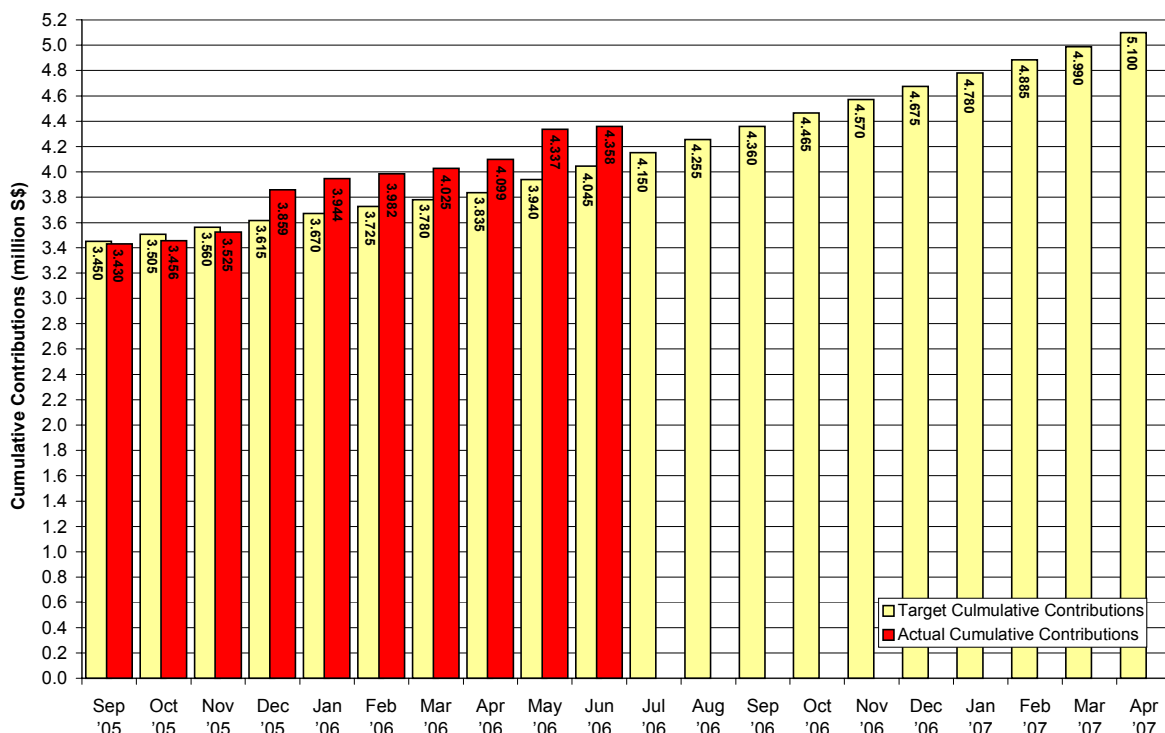
PRAYER ITEMS ... pray without ceasing
